From the President



Dear Chesapeake Music Donors and Patrons,

One of the privileges of being president of Chesapeake Music is that I get to meet and know so many of you, generous music lovers whose contributions make it possible to keep the music playing. Without your support, we would have to dim our lights, casting a pall over the rich cultural life of our Eastern Shore community.

With your help though, this past year has been an exciting one, with a rich calendar of events as the disruption of the pandemic grew hazier in our rear-view mirror. This past October, the Zelter Quartet, winner of the 2021 International Chamber Music Competition Lerman Gold Prize, whose award winning presentation was viewed virtually due to covid-19 restrictions, thrilled an audience with a live presentation at the Ebenezer Theater. Valentines Day weekend was made festive with a concert of piano pieces and piano-cello duets by 2022 Rising Stars, pianist Elliot Wu and cellist Sterling Elliot.

On Saturday, April 2, the entire day was devoted to the 10th International Chamber Music Competition, as it returned to its normal biennial schedule after the disruption of the virus pandemic. Five young, extraordinary groups energetically competed; Trio Colores, the Swiss percussion ensemble, winning both the Lerman Gold Prize and the Audience Choice award, highlighting the international nature of the event.

Once again, we were *delighted, engaged and surprised* by the program and performances of the renowned musicians of the 37th Chesapeake Chamber Music Festival. The festival of concerts and open rehearsals is the cornerstone of Chesapeake Music’s programming and is noteworthy in so many ways.

Our 2021–2022 concert lineup concluded with a sold-out jazz presentation by the Loston Harris Trio, featuring the American song book in a sophisticated and urbane style.

I hope you are as proud as I am of the exciting programming Chesapeake Music brings to the Eastern Shore. Your support allows us to do this and to explore new ways to fulfill our mission to *delight, engage and surprise today’s audiences, and educate, inspire and develop tomorrow’s*. All of us at Chesapeake Music are inspired by your generosity, it inspires us as we plan for the future.

I thank each of you for your contribution and encourage you to respond to our Annual Appeal.
